All members of age 18 and above are eligible to vote.

When not otherwise required by the table above, the Church may employ, as appropriate, any of the four following methods of recording a vote:

- 1. Voice vote (yes/no) for the general consent of routine motions, such as approving minutes, etc.
- 2. Standing
- 3. Raised hands
- 4. Ballot vote

By passage of a subordinate motion by two-thirds vote, the assembly may require a higher percentage for passage of the main motion.
