Students must be class age on or before September 1, 2024. Three- year- olds must be fully potty trained (able to attend to own needs with no teacher help) to participate in the 3 year old program. **Your child's enrollment is confirmed upon receipt of the completed enrollment form AND the registration fee. The *registration fee is a separate fee and does not apply toward tuition. The registration fee is non-refundable.** Tuition is due on the first school day of each month. Please make checks payable to LBC and write MMO/WP and the month the tuition is for on the "for" line. If paying in cash, please use exact change. Online payment is also available. If you choose this option, please make sure that you specify that your payment is for Mother's Morning Out or Weekday Preschool, the name of the child the payment is for, and notify the MMO/WP Director that you paid online. We appreciate your prompt payment as we are a self-supporting ministry. Teacher salaries come solely from tuition.

Hours of operation are 8:30 a.m. – 12:15 p.m. First day of MMO & WP is August 5, 2024. Last day is May 16, 2025. Please see the MMO and Weekday Preschool Handbook for additional information regarding policies, procedures, curriculum, etc.

LBC MMO/WP accepts children of any race, color, national and ethnic origin. LBC MMO/WP is not equipped to care for the special needs of physically and/or mentally challenged children or children with developmental disorders.

*The registration fee is used to purchase curriculum, art materials, supplies and snacks.

I understand that in the event of an emergency Lizella Baptist Church, its employees and agents, will make every effort to contact me. However, if I cannot be reached, I give my permission to an authorized employee, volunteer or other representative of Lizella Baptist Church to secure the services of a licensed physician to provide the necessary care, including anesthesia, for my child's well-being.

WELCOME TO LIZELLA BAPTIST'S

MOTHER'S MORNING OUT and WEEKDAY PRESCHOOL

The Mother's Morning Out and Weekday Preschool (MMO)/WP programs are for children who are 12 months (must be walking) to 4 years old on or by September 1, 2024.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this ministry is to provide a safe, happy, loving, structured environment so preschoolers can learn in the ways they learn best; to give them a solid learning foundation in an enjoyable atmosphere so that they will have a desire to continue learning.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Child must be class age on or before September 1.
- Children entering 3K program must be fully potty trained. This includes the ability to pull up/down pants, wipe themselves, and wash their hands.
- Children entering Mother's Morning Out must be walking.

CURRICULUM

Our classes will use the A Beka Book curriculum. This is a quality curriculum written from a Christian perspective. Preschoolers are active learners who need to move, explore, and discover, using their curiosity and five senses to learn. Learning Centers utilized in our programs will include:

- Art
- Blocks
- Books
- Home
- Music
- Science/Nature
- Puzzles and Manipulatives

WAYS PARENTS CAN HELP

- Become familiar with MMO/WP policies and cooperate in every way possible. We are eager for your child to have happy experiences at LBC and trust that you will be willing to help us.
- As you bring your child to MMO/WP, give him a hug and a smile and tell him you will be back soon. Then leave immediately.
- Reinforce at home what your child is learning in school.

IMMUNIZATIONS

An updated immunization form #3231 is required for each child that attends MMM/WP. You may request this information from your pediatrician or the local Health Department. Your child may not begin either program until we have this information on file. Please bring an updated certificate whenever your child receives new immunizations.

ILLNESS

Upon the recommendation of the Committee on Control of Infectious Diseases of the American Academy of Pediatrics, no child will be admitted to MMO/WP when he or she has any of the following symptoms:

- Acute cold
- Fever greater than 99.5 degrees
- Severe coughing
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Strep/Sore throat
- Runny nose with yellow or green discharge
- Bronchitis or Flu
- Earache
- Red or discharging eyes
- Skin rash
- Chills
- Lice
- Covid 19 symptoms – please follow current CDC recommendations regarding isolation and quarantine following exposure.

Your cooperation in helping to keep all of our children well is appreciated.

If a child develops a fever or other symptoms of illness while at MMO/WP, he will be isolated and the parents will be contacted to take the child home.

We will not administer medication (with the exception of an EpiPen). This is a very serious responsibility which must be supervised by the parents.

If your child should develop an infectious disease following a Mother's Morning Out or Weekday Preschool session, please contact the director immediately.

Please inform the MMO/WP staff of any allergies your child has.

WHAT CHILDREN NEED TO BRING EVERY DAY

- Spill-proof cup (all children)
- Disposable diapers or Pull-ups if child is not potty-trained (Mother's Morning Out only; at least 2 per day)
- Extra set of clothes, including shoes and socks. This is especially important for those being potty-trained.
- Book Bag (3 and 4 year olds only). Please purchase a bag that is big enough to put papers and projects in. (Please do not fill the book bag with toys, blankets, etc. We need space to put things in!)

Please label all belongings with your child's name.

Other supplies are provided through the registration fee, including a mid-morning snack.

TOYS

Children are asked not to bring toys from home as preschoolers usually find it very difficult to share. The MMO/WP programs will provide appropriate toys and materials for learning.

CLOTHING

We suggest comfortable, machine washable play clothes. Preschoolers will use paint, markers and glue and play outside. For the child in diapers, clothing should be easy to change, with a minimum of snaps and buttons. For the child who is potty trained, clothing should be simple enough for them to manage on their own. When choosing footwear, keep in mind that children run and climb. Sandals and flip-flops are not recommended. Closed-in, rubber-soled shoes are a better choice. During cool weather, please send an appropriate sweater, jacket or coat for outside play.

REGISTRATION

- Registration will begin in February for the 2024-2025 year on a first come, first served basis.
- The registration fee for the 2024-2025 school year is equivalent to one month's tuition and is payable at the time of registration. (i.e., if your child's monthly tuition will be \$165, then the registration fee is \$165.)
- Your child's enrollment is confirmed upon receipt of the registration fee and the required forms.
- **The registration fee is separate and does not apply toward tuition.**
- **The registration fee is non-refundable.**
- Enrolled children are not automatically enrolled for the next year. A new registration form along with the registration/supply fee must be submitted in order to re-enroll.
- Registration forms are available at the Preschool welcome desk or by calling the Preschool Office at 478-935-8632.

TUITION & SCHEDULE FOR THE 2024-2025 YEAR

Tuition will be due on the first school day of every month, August-May. Please make checks payable to LBC. Be sure to include your child's name and MMO/WP and the month the tuition is for on the "for" line on your check. If paying in cash, please use exact change and get a receipt from the MMO/WP Director. Online payment is also available. If you choose this option, please make sure that you specify that your payment is for Mother's Morning Out or Weekday Preschool, the name of the child the payment is for, and notify your child's teacher or the Director that you paid online. We appreciate your prompt payment as we are a self-supporting ministry. Fees/tuition cannot be refunded nor deductions given for temporary illness or absence as our expenses remain the same whether or not your child is in attendance.

We expect you to commit to the entire school year as teachers will be hired based on beginning of the year enrollment. Again, we are a self-supporting ministry. It would be very difficult to fill your child's spot after the school year begins.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Children should be brought to their classroom by an adult in the mornings no earlier than 8:25 a.m. Please sign your child in on the form provided. Children will be dismissed from the door at the covered drive-thru at 12:15 p.m. Please wait outside for your child. If someone other than those listed as authorized on the enrollment form must pick your child up, please tell the teacher at drop off or text in advance to advise the teacher of this change.

For the safety and security of our students, we ask that parents do not enter the classrooms when dropping children off in the mornings. Mornings can be quite hectic and teachers must remain focused on the children. If you are dropping off a child in the Mother's Morning Out or 2 year old class, we ask that you hang your child's diaper bag or bookbag on the assigned hook in the hallway and bring your child, 2 diapers and their spillproof cup to the door. The teacher will meet you at the door and accept the diapers and cup from you as she admits your child into the classroom.

LATE PICK-UP FEE

Please pick your child up at 12:15 p.m. Teachers must prepare for the next day and may have personal appointments and obligations after that time. Unless there is an emergency, there will be a \$10 late charge payable upon arrival.

HOLIDAYS/INCLEMENT WEATHER

Holidays and breaks will be scheduled as closely as possible with schools in the surrounding areas. If the church office is closed, MMO/WP will be closed also. In the case of inclement weather, we will follow the same schedule as Bibb County Public Schools. An attempt will be made to contact you by phone or text if MMO/WP is canceled.

CELEBRATIONS

BIRTHDAYS

It is permissible for parents to bring refreshments for the class on or near their child's birthday. These may be brought to school at the beginning of the day and will be served at our regular snack time. Due to the prevalence of allergies, we ask that you bring **NO PEANUTS OR PEANUT BUTTER PRODUCTS**. Please do not send favors for the children to take home.

We will hand out invitations for your child's private party only if the entire class is invited.

HOLIDAYS

As part of holiday observations we will talk about God's creation, Jesus' Birth, Spring and new life.

Secular holiday personalities (witches, ghosts, Santa Clause, Rudolph, Easter Bunny, etc.) will not be used in MMO/WP. Please do not send them as a snack, craft, prize, etc.

SAFETY

For your child's safety:

All of our personnel have current background checks

All of our classrooms have windows in the doors with unobstructed views into classroom

Only parents or parent-authorized adults are allowed to pick up a child from MMO/WP

Toys and equipment are age-appropriate

Emergency procedures are posted in each classroom

ATTENDANCE

It is important that your child arrive on time every day. Classes will begin promptly at 8:30. Your child will miss out if they are late.

STUDENT WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE

A two-week notice should be made for any withdrawals during the school year. Please complete the withdrawal form located in the back of this handbook and give it to the MMO/WP Director. Tuition must be paid through the end of the month during which you withdraw.

PARENT VISITATION

Parents are welcome to tour our facilities after classes are dismissed for the day or during the summer before classes begin. However, for security purposes and so as to not disrupt classes, parents may not visit classrooms during the school day.

Parent/Teacher Conferences: We ask that if you need to speak to the teacher, you schedule a meeting for the end of the MMO/WP day after all children have left or phone them later. During the school day the teacher's attention must remain focused on the children.

DISCIPLINE

- All students are expected to use appropriate behavior and language in school.
- Discipline is by positive guidance and distraction from undesired behavior.
- Time-Out may be used as needed. (1 minute per year of child's age – a 2 year old would have a 2 minute time out.)
- If time out and redirecting do not work, students will be sent to the MMO/WP director.
- Students who cause physical harm to others (biting, hitting, kicking, etc.), will be sent to the MMO/WP Director and parents will be notified of the behavior. At the third offense, parents may be asked to keep student out of class for two weeks.

If your child is old enough to be enrolled in the 4K class, but did not attend 3K anywhere, you might consider having them do 3K first, unless they know the name of each letter and the sound it makes. The 4K curriculum assumes children know this.
